What is Pearson?

Pearson is a British multinational publishing and education company based in London. They have changed considerably over the last 300 years starting from publishing under the Longman brand and developing into the world's largest education and publishing company. What type of support does Pearson provide?

In 2010 Pearson Test of English (General or Young Learners) became available in Ukraine. More than 20 test sessions have taken place since then, and over 3000 test-takers have received certificates.

In 2014 LCCI International Qualifications in Business English were also introduced into Ukraine. Ukrainian test-takers took their first LCCI English for Business exam in December 2015.

Pearson representatives work closely with the Ukrainian Ministry of Education to develop effective education solutions for schools, higher education and government institutions, including the development of External independent Testing.
